### CITY OF LONG BEACH RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, WASHINGTON,

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant grantees are responsible for resolving local complaints; and

WHEREAS, Grantees are required by federal regulation [(24 CFR 570.486(a)(7)] to establish a procedure for handling any written complaints with the local management, operational procedures and administration of CDBG funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

### Section 1.

The following policies and procedures are adopted to serve as a guide for the City of Long Beach's complaint process in relation to the CDBG program.

- 1. Submit complaints in writing to the City Administrator for resolution. A record of the complaints and action taken will be maintained. A decision by the City Administrator will be rendered within 15 working days.
- 2. If the complaint cannot be resolved to your satisfaction by the designated official,

The complaint will be heard and discussed by the City Council at an open, public meeting. A written decision will be made within 30 working days. The decision of the City Council is final.

3. A record of action taken on each complaint will be maintained as a part of the records or minutes at each level of the grievance process.

<u>Section 2.</u> Effective Date. This resolution, being an exercise of power specifically delegated to the city legislative body, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after passage by the City Council.
